Dear CCCS Parents,

I hope this letter finds you resting in God's peace. As we continue to adapt to the ever changing conditions that we face, I wanted to give to you a few more protocols that we are putting in place for our August 5<sup>th</sup> start up. I want to remind you that we are balancing two important priorities: the need for students to be back in the classroom and the safety of our students, staff, and all of their families. We do feel we have a strong, workable plan that addresses both of these concerns.

As I mentioned in our previous letter, we don't feel we can realistically social distance children in their individual classrooms. Therefore our goal is to isolate each classroom, thus greatly limiting the number of contacts each student will have during the school day. With "social distancing of the classrooms" as our goal, we will add the following protocols to our school day.

- Student and teachers will not be required to wear face masks in the classrooms. They will be optional there. But, students and teachers will be required to wear them anytime they leave their classroom. Students will be required to wear a mask when entering and exiting the building during carpool. Once they reach their classroom or their car, they can remove them. They will be required to wear them going to and from the lunchroom or the rest room or to go to recess. Once they have reached their destination, the mask can be removed.
- All visitors and volunteers to the school will be required to wear a face mask. This will include all lunchroom volunteers.
- Each class will eat separately in the lunchroom, and each will have their own individual recess period. The lunchroom tables and chairs will be cleaned between each class.
- Students will not be changing classrooms on the back hall (third through fifth grades). Instead, the teachers will be moving between the class rooms. This will eliminate the sharing of desks and chairs between different classes.

Again, students will be allowed to wear masks in the classrooms if parent so desire. We will leave that decision up to our parents.

Thanks for your faithful support to our school. I appreciate your feedback and support of our plans to reopen. Like you, we are praying for wisdom as we make these important decisions.
